- No bent or broken tubing or sheet metal
- No debris in wheels
- All wheels secure, rolling and swiveling properly
- Wheel locks hold wheel securely
- Side rails move and latch properly
- Height and positioning latch functioning properly
- Cot secure in each height position
- Undercarriage folds properly
- Safety bar operating properly
- No rips or cracks in the mattress cover
- Body restraints positioned, intact and working properly
